



## CANADIAN PRIMARY ALUMINIUM PRODUCTION MONTHLY REPORT

**November 3, 2021** — The Aluminium Association of Canada reports that primary aluminium production in Canada in October 2021 totalled 252,916 metric tons. The monthly production was up 3,40% in comparison with the month of September 2021. The year-to-date average daily production is 8,678 tons. Compared to last year, the annual projection of production would be up by 1.56%.
